He was the second of four brothers; his youngest two brothers died of malnutrition and lack of care.

His search for food led him to an elementary school, where he was fed a small meal every day. He survived, studied, and eventually won scholarships to attend college. He later earned a master's degree from California State University.

Today, Thomas works with Catholic Relief Services as integral part in bringing global solidarity. He lives in Ghana with his wife and four children.
